

I, _____, a massage client of Jenifer Crandell, LMP #MA00023516, at Escape For A Day Massage & Spa in Vancouver, WA have read the below policy and agree to all it entails regarding what the therapist/practitioner expects of me while I am receiving services. I also have read the statement of what I can expect from my therapist/practitioner during a massage/spa session. By signing this policy statement, I hereby give up the right to state that I was treated in any other manner, than which I received. I also relinquish my right to state that I had never been explained what does or could take place during a massage. I understand that the therapist is conducting massage/spa services for therapeutic reasons and nothing more.

_____By initialing here, I, the said client above, will be expected to receive a full body massage, while trusting in my therapist to never take advantage of me, or my body, while I receive massage/spa services. At any time my therapist/practitioner reserves the right to ask for payment in advance for any service(s) rendered, and I agree to such expectations from me. If I do not agree to pay the upfront fees, I will not receive any service(s). With that said, my therapist/practitioner has explained to me verbally and in this policy, that should I act out of boundaries set by the therapist/practitioner, I will be asked to get dressed, pay, and promptly leave the premises. I will also note, that I will be reported to the proper authorities for such conduct. In respect for myself, and my therapist/practitioner, I will refrain from lude comments regarding sexual misconduct, inappropriate table behavior including but not limited to the following; gyrating on the table, grinding into the table, thrusting of genitals/scrotum/vagina towards my therapist/practitioner, while she works on me. I will not make any sexual comments regarding myself or the therapist/practitioner, anything of a sexual nature, or asking for sexual favors during my massage/spa service. Anything that can be misconstrued as such behavior will lead to the immediate vacation of the premises. I understand that I am being asked to sign this policy to protect not only myself, but my therapist as well. Whether I am receiving a full drape, spa drape, or no-drape massage, I will always act in a non-sexual, professional, and respectful manner while receiving massage and spa services. My therapist/practitioner has explained to me that at anytime I feel like my comfort level/boundaries are being jeopardized or I feel like any of the services I am receiving feel questionable regarding intent of services from my therapist/practitioner, I can communicate with her about the issues while on the table, she will stop the massage, drape me accordingly to what kind of massage I am receiving and we will discuss whether to continue the massage or whether I feel I need to leave. While discussing the terms of the massage, I can feel free to sit up on the table or remain lying down on my back or stomach, whichever I am on, when I bring up the issue of my comfort level being compromised. I agree to communicate with my therapist/practitioner, at all times, while receiving massage/spa services, to ensure both our comfort levels, boundaries, and the intent we both bring to the massage/spa services. If at any time, while receiving a massage regardless of how I am draped, in the adductors (inner thighs), abdomen (stomach region & top of pelvis), and glutes (buttocks) area(s), I am accidentally bumped, brushed, or the therapist/practitioner comes into contact with any part of my genitalia/scrotum/vaginal area, it is purely accidental and know that while working in those areas it can happen. In the case any of these stated incidents should take place, I know that the therapists' intent is purely therapeutic and at no time is to be misconstrued

as sexual misconduct. If I should feel uncomfortable about the services and do not communicate with my therapist/practitioner during the massage/spa session, I relinquish the right to complain later that my needs were not met or dealt with in the appropriate manner. With that said, if I still feel that the therapist/practitioner has not taken my comments about the matter seriously, I can feel free to try to communicate with her in a more thorough manner or I can feel free to report her to the state massage board for review of the services she is providing.

_____By initialing here, I, the said client above, also understand and agree, that at any time my therapist/practitioner feels as though her practice is in jeopardy regarding the intent of a client during services, she reserves the right to record any conversation in her office, with the client's knowledge that I may be recorded at any time during our session, as the therapist/practitioner sees fit. Such recordings will be used in any hearing at a trial where it is permissible by the court, given as a statement to the police of what took place during our massage/spa session, or to back up any alleged allegations I bring toward my therapist/practitioner, or that my therapist/practitioner may bring toward me.

I, _____, have explained to my client, _____, that they can trust and confide in me during their massage/spa session if I bring any questionable intent to my massage/spa services. I will listen to the client, adjust their service accordingly and continue on with their service, assuming that there is no need to end the session at hand. I will always respect the wishes of my client regarding their intent while receiving massage/spa services in my office or during a mobile service. I will at no time accept any belligerent behavior, sexually explicit conversations, request for sexual favors, gyrating on the table, thrusting into the table, thrusting towards my hand while rendering services to my client, or any other behavior that can be misconstrued as having any sexual misconduct behind it. I will always remain professional and stay within my scope of practice. With that said, I do not, and am not at this time planning on getting special permits/permissions to do such modalities (types) of massage as paraneal massage or prostate massage. If at any time while working (massaging or applying product) to the adductors (inner thighs), glutes (buttocks), or the abdomen (stomach & top of pelvic region), should I bump, brush, or come into contact with such areas, it should not be misconstrued with having anything to do with sexual misconduct but rather an accidental event. When working in this area, especially with a client that is partially draped with a spa drape (a towel) or no drape, it has been known to take place when working the area, but is not acceptable to keep happening especially if the intent is anything but therapeutic. Should you question the intent behind such said events, should they take place, I want my client to communicate with me any discomfort or mistrust they have or feel towards/from me. As stated above, I will stop the massage/spa session; drape my client accordingly to the type of service they are receiving and speak with my client. If they should feel as they need to end such services or feel that the services have been compromised, after communicating with me respectfully, I will allow them to get dressed, and leave the premises without payment of services rendered. At any time I should feel the need to charge up front for services about to be

rendered, my client will understand and will pay up front or they will not receive services. At any time I feel as though my practice is in jeopardy regarding the intent of a client during services, I reserve the right to record any conversation in my office, with the client's knowledge that I may be recording them at any time during our session as I see fit. Such recordings will be used in any hearing at a trial where it is permissible by the court, given as a statement to the police of what took place during our massage/spa session, or to back up any alleged allegations I bring toward a client, or a client may bring toward me.

_____By initialing here, I, the licensed massage practitioner, am stating that I offer different draping options for the comfort of my client(s). I offer three different draping options; a full sheet drape, a spa drape (a towel), which will cover the gluteal cleft (crack of buttocks), genitalia/scrotum/vaginal area/nipples on women), & the no drape option (nude while on massage table, face up & face down). I will always provide a drape for my client(s), but should they decline such drape, I am comfortable with all aspects of draping or the aspects of a non-draped massage, within the client(s) comfort level. By offering a no-drape massage, my clients know and understand that I do not condone any sexual misconduct during any massage/spa session. If at any time, a client abuses the freedom of a no-drape massage, they will be asked to get dressed, pay for services rendered, and asked to vacate the premises. The client may also be reported to the proper authorities and asked to never enter the premises again. If this should happen another policy must be signed by client and therapist/practitioner, with the understanding that services will not be rendered under any circumstances in the future, unless it is agreed upon by both parties.

This policy is in place to protect the client, the licensed massage therapist/practitioner, and Escape For A Day Massage & Spa from any liability concerning any inappropriate misconduct during a massage/spa session, whether it is an office visit or a mobile visit to a client(s) house, apartment, office, facility, or hotel/motel room. This policy MUST be signed and date by both parties to be a legal and binding contract. If this policy is not signed and dated by both parties, it will be considered null and void. With that said, this policy MUST be signed and dated by both parties or services will NOT be rendered.

I wish to take this time and opportunity to thank my client(s) for understanding my need to put this policy into place and for their willingness to sign it to receive my services. This policy is in place to protect all of us legally for any actions that can be misconstrued as anything but purely therapeutic healthcare, from a licensed massage practitioner.
